How Rep. Emily Randall voted on House Bills

H.R. 35	No, passed by a vote of 264-155	The Agent Raul Gonzalez Officer Safety Act would impose criminal and immigration penalties for intentionally fleeing a pursuing Federal officer while operating a motor vehicle.
H.R. 77	No, passed by a vote of 212-208	The Midnight Rules Relief Act would make it easier to overturn rules implemented during the previous administration.
H.R. 736	Yes, passed by a vote of 408-0	The Protect Small Businesses from Excessive Paperwork Act would extend the deadline for certain companies that are required to file beneficial ownership information with the Financial Crimes Enforcement Network.
